

Adrian Lesenciuc is an Associate Professor of Theory of Communication and Military Sciences and currently he is the president of the 'Henri Coandă' Air Force Academy Senate in Braşov. He has a PhD in

Military Sciences from 'Carol I' National Defense University (2008-2011) and in Communication Sciences from National University of Political Sciences and Administration (2010-2014), both in Bucharest. His major interest in research concerns intercultural communication, but he has also been interested in studying fundamentals of communication in military sciences, communicative competence, and linguistics. He designed the international conference Redefining Community in Intercultural Context (starting with 2011), quoted in important scientific databases, such as Thomson Reuters / Web of Knowledge or Index Copernicus.
